«Future Economic Systems»

How well does our economic system work? And how sustainable is it? The recent financial and economic crises as well as socio-political changes are reason to rethink our economic system and the market economy. Academia Engelberg Foundation's 14th Dialogue on Science provides a pluralistic platform with intergenerational discussions of new ideas on these topics. Experts from science, business, politics and society will discuss which solutions, if any, criticism of capitalism offers or what an ecological and social market economy might look like. They will also analyze the impact on the market economy of digital developments and Generation Y's demands. Speakers like Anthony E. Gortzis, University of Athens; the president of Economiesuisse, Heinz Karrer; Bina Agarwal of the University of Manchester and a representative of Google as well as some 30 students from this year's summer school will kick off the discussion. At the 14th Dialogue on Science in the monastery village of Engelberg, the participants and over 30 speakers will have the opportunity to exchange their views, to network, and to develop possible new solutions.
