The Swiss alpine town of Engelberg, located near Lucerne, offers an ideal platform for forging new contacts and fostering intergenerational exchange and contact among participants.

The 2018 «ENGELBERG DIALOGUES» will focus on **«Unlimited Migration?»**

Young scientists will discuss various aspects of this topic during the **«Autumn Academy»** (October 14 to 16). Their major ideas will be further developed during the **half-day «Workshop»** (October 16, afternoon) together with experts and interested guests from politics, sciences and business. «Thematic Cafés» offer in-depth discussions among the participants and are summarized during the closing plenary session.

The **one-day Forum** (October 17) will open with the keynote talk by Prof. Christian Dustmann (University College London, UK), an internationally renowned economist. After the presentation of the findings and results from the preceding Autumn Academy and the Workshop, participants will form into discussion groups fashioned along the lines of an OpenSpace conference. A panel of renowned academics, businesspeople and policymakers will share their visions in regard to migration. Panel members include Prof. Christian Dustmann, Prof. Michael Ambühl (Professor at ETH Zurich and former State Secretary in the Foreign and Finance

Ministry in Switzerland), Dr. Sanja Damjanović (Minister of Science, Montenegro) and Hans-Rudolf Schurter (Chairman of the Board of Schurter Holding AG, Lucerne, Switzerland).
